CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Shaner, Superintendent, recapped the August 15, 2013 Retreat and introduced Kay Cornell, Strategic Planning Consultant. Mrs. Cornell lead the group through a process of thinking about their hopes/dreams, fears and commitments. By creating a culture that is connected, caring, and nurturing one can deal with just about any situation. She stated it is important to have the courage to do the right thing and to be true to what you believe. The group identified their commitments as a Board, including strengths, challenges, conflicts, trust, focus on results and accountability.
