New Business

Recommendation for Award of contract and Approval of Current Project Costs for Districtwide Building Automation System Integration Bid

Assistant Superintendent for Business, Dana Taylor reviewed the recommendation for the contract award.

On Tuesday, March 9, 2017, the district received three (3) bids for the District-wide Building Automation System Integration Bid.

A request for bids was issued April 25, 2017, with advertising on the district's Purchasing Department website, on the Buy4Michigan website, and in the Rochester Post.

Bids were reviewed and evaluated by a team from Frank Rewold and Son Inc., and by Pete Muscio, Director of Capital Projects for Rochester Community Schools. All of the accepted bids were found to be initially compliant with the required specifications per the detail in the bid summary. The bids were analyzed on bid content, completeness, inclusion of required submittals, and compliance with required

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specifications. Interviews began with the low bid vendor in each category and included in-depth evaluations.

Based on this information, we recommend that the Board of Education awards the following contracts to:

Bid

PackDescriptionVendorAmountABuilding Automation System IntegrationControl Solutions, Inc.\$50,707

for a contract sum of \$50,707.00, and we recommend that the Board of Education approve the Other Project Costs, in the amount of \$54,430.00, for a Total of Current Project Costs for May 22, 2017, in the amount of \$105,137.00.

Mike Gagnon addressed the Board to explain the Building Automation System Integration bid in detail.

Board discussion included costs, development of cloud based software, references for Control Solutions, Inc. and if this software will be installed in all schools. Dr. Shaner confirmed that this program will be installed in every district facility.

Motion to approve awarding of contract and approval of current project costs for District-wide Building Automation Systems Integration Bid, as presented.
